The dramatic and familiar events of the book of Exodus?

No, on this occasion it was **Covenant Players' 50th Anniversary Retreat**, in Beaumont (via Idyllwild), California.

THE PRESENT

As Covenant Players and guests from across the world prepared to travel to our retreat site in Idyllwild, California, news reports warned of wild fires in the area, but calls to the site had confirmed both our safety and anticipated arrival.

However, not long after arriving in Idyllwild, we were informed that, due to a rapidly developing situation, we were being evacuated from the retreat site to an as yet unspecified accommodations below. We were then led in caravan formation down the moun-

No one could have planned or even anticipated the events of this retreat. It was as if He had picked us up by His hand and moved us into the situation He had designed for us.

Quickly, Covenant Players jumped in to help, as hundreds of camp beds arrived and were erected in the large gymnasium. Food started to arrive from Red Cross sources, community businesses and members of the public. Right there, amongst the cots, on that first night, 114 Covenant Players plus members of the evacuated community, sang worship songs, read from the word and worshipped God.

Thus began an incredible shared time together of spiritual and community renewal. Members of both



We are excited to announce that **our long hoped for return visit to Kenya, East Africa will soon be a reality!** From 7-21 November, Covenant Players Joe Medley and David Groves will return to Kenya for the first time in over 15 years! Kenyan Pastor Noah Mapesa is busy arranging a series of

evangelistic outreaches for drama ministry in towns and villages throughout his region of Western Kenya.

The visit was originally scheduled for March of this year, but shortly before the planned trip, Pastor Noah wrote asking us to postpone our coming because of the possibility of unrest in the country due to

the Idyllwild and Beaumont communities - as well as members of the Red Cross - joined us to share in our retreat activities and lives were touched and changed by what took place there. Many expressed how it must have been God's plan to bring them to be with us.

Of their own volition, staff of Beaumont High School came in to open up and run the spectacular state of the art theatre in which we were invited to perform our plays. (All our equipment having been left behind upon the evacuation order.) The school's kitchen staff, on summer vacation, offered to open up the kitchens and pre-

pared incredible hot meals for us each day. The school district transport staff offered assistance should we need it.

THE PAST

And how word spread about the plays. When the plays had been selected, weeks before, we could not have anticipated the impact of performing *WHERE THE HEART IS*,

one of Chuck's first plays and set in a lifesaving sta-

tion, for volunteers of the Red Cross, nor *WAR CASUALTIES*, set in a field hospital in the Second World War. Neither could we have envisioned a special performance for about 20 representatives of the district school board.

The retreat culminated in a wonderful worship service on the Sunday morning, at which several of the community and volun-
